

Student Retention

For İstanbul Bilgi University the ability of its students to graduate is also an indicator of student success. Thus, while the tracking of graduation rates and time to graduation is important, it is equally crucial to monitor student retention each year.

In order to understand why students drop out, a data mining project was initiated in 2016 and student data from the last four years were analyzed to determine the common indicators for students that had dropped out. In light of the data, improvement and tracking efforts were initiated to address the factors causing the students' departure.

One of the follow-up studies was to track the reports of drop-out students and understand their reasons for dropping out and initiate improvements to address those reasons. Additionally, to prevent any student group from becoming disadvantaged, reporting and tracking was done for various segments.
